Fireside Lodge Casegoods

Solid wood face frames

All Fireside Lodge casegoods use solid wood face frames.

Solid wood drawer fronts

All of our drawer fronts are made from solid wood and then attached to our four-sided drawer boxes

STURDY Compliant

All Fireside Lodge bedroom casegoods meet the most recent iteration of the STURDY act.

Glued & Screwed

All structural elements of our casegoods are glued and screwed for lasting durability.

Stains & Finishes

Fireside Lodge only uses premium, low-VOC stains and finishes. Our standard finish is a clear coat, catalyzed lacquer with a matte finish.

We also offer an upgrade Armor finish which is a premium quality, post-catalyzed, alkyd-amino varnish that is formulated to offer superior durability, and UV protection.

Drawer Box Construction

All our drawer boxes are four-sided with the drawer front attached to the outside. Using our CNC machine, every piece is precision-cut.



Dovetail Joinery

Our craftspeople use French dovetails to join our four-sided drawer boxes thereby creating a stronger joint and finished look.



Aromatic Cedar Bottoms

Fireside Lodge's Premium casegoods feature aromatic cedar drawer bottoms that add to the heirloom-quality build of our furniture.



Drawer Glides

Our full-extension, soft-close drawer glides are rated to 100 lbs and help increase the longevity of our casegoods.

STURDY Act Overview

The STURDY Act (Stop Tip-overs of Unstable, Risky Dressers on Youth Act) was announced and signed into law during December 2022.

What Did This Change?

Not much. Even before this act was signed into law, Fireside Lodge met or exceeded many of the standards; however, we enacted the below changes on all our bedroom casegoods for good measure:

Top Drawers

The top drawer on casegoods affected by STURDY had the depth guide shortened by 2 inches. The drawers themselves are still the same size, and to prevent any possible tip-over, we found this to be the best solution without reducing drawer sizes.

Melamine Backing

Fireside Lodge also changed the back of our dressers and chests to use melamine instead of plywood. As a heavier, denser material, it acts as a counterweight thereby ensuring that it stays upright even when the drawers are fully extended and holding additional weight.



Front Stretchers

All our case goods use solid wood front stretchers that are attached to the face frame using wood glue and pocket screws. They add another dimension of stability to the furniture and reinforce the face frame.

Back Stretchers

The back stretchers are found in each drawer bay and ensure the case good is not only square, but is ready to meet the rigors of daily use.

Drawer Runners

Made from solid aspen, our drawer runners serve a dual purpose: a place to affix the drawer guides and they also help keep the overall piece square and stable.
